The first teaching of the Buddha after his awakening was the teaching of the Four Noble Truths. This profound, yet basic teaching is fundamental to all Buddhist traditions and consists of the teachings of how and why we suffer and how to end our suffering. The four noble truths are: the truth of suffering, the truth of the cause of suffering, the truth of the end of suffering and the truth of the path leading to the end of suffering or the eight-fold path. In this daylong, we will explore these four noble truths through meditation, talks and group discussions.
